RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Tournament to be governed by FIFA rules unless otherwise stated below.** It is the captain/coach's duty to make sure that the team members are conversant with both FIFA and tournament rules. Ignorance of the same will not be accepted as a valid excuse.
- 2.** Points to be awarded in group phase on following basis:
Three (3) points for a win and one (1) point for a draw.
- 3.** Top two teams in each group advance to the next round. If two teams are equal on points then the team that won the match between those two teams will go through. If that match ended in a draw, than the criteria for advancing will firstly be goal difference, and if still equal, then goals scored by each team. In the event that both teams cannot still be separated, than the issue will be resolved by a coin toss.
- 4.** Teams to report to the ground no later than thirty (30) minutes before kick-off. Match will start if each team has a minimum of seven (7) players. **No grace period** will be given after kick-off time and a walk-over will be awarded immediately to the team present. **No show of a team at the ground without prior intimation may result in disqualification from the current and future tournaments.**
- 5.** Coaches to ensure that all team members are in the same kit (jerseys, shorts and socks). Football boots and shin-pads are mandatory. No latitude will be allowed to the rule.
- 6.** If for some reason the match cannot be played or completed due to no fault of the participating teams (**i.e. floodlights failure**), then in the first instance, the match will be replayed at another date. If a match cannot be completed second time round due to floodlights failure, then the result will be determined by a penalty shoot-out. For avoidance of doubt it is clarified that if a match is stopped due to floodlight failure or other similar reason without the first half being completed, then the match will be replayed in its entirety. If the match is stopped due to floodlights failure or any other similar reason in the second half, then only the remaining portion of the match will be replayed. In the event there is a "no result" due to both teams failing to appear at the ground due to their own negligence, neither team will be awarded any points.
- 7.** In the knock-out stage, there will be two extra-time periods of 10 minutes whereafter, there will be a penalty shoot-out. **The "golden goal" and "silver goal" rules will not apply.**
- 8.** Any player who receives yellow cards in consecutive games shall be ineligible to play the next game. A red card will also result in the concerned player(s) being ejected from the instant game as well as his becoming ineligible for his side's next game. **A single yellow card will not be carried over to the knockout stage.** However, a player who has received a yellow card in either of his team's first

two games and then receives a second yellow card in his team's 3rd and last game, will be ineligible to play in the first game of the knock-out stage.

9. A school can only field a player who is studying at the said institution for the academic year 2009-2010 and whose age at as at December 15, 2009 is less than twenty years. Only those players will be allowed to compete in the tournament that are named in the original list of twenty names submitted prior to commencement of the Tournament. Date of Birth and picture of players will be stamped and signed by principal of the school. **Any school fielding an over-age player or those not currently studying at the said institution, will result in the school being disqualified from the current and future tournaments.**
10. Students at schools who are enlisted with Department teams as football players are not eligible to participate.
11. Institutions and/or students who may have participated in inter-university level tournaments are not eligible to participate.
12. Protests by any team as regards the eligibility of any player or otherwise has to be made in writing and must be handed over to the Match Commissioner or member of the Disciplinary Committee no later than twenty-four hours after the match to which the protest pertains. **Burden of proof is on the protesting team.**
13. In the any event player is rendered unable to play because of an injury sustained during the course of the Tournament, a request for a replacement will have to be submitted to the members of the Tournament Organising Committee whose decision in this regard will be final.
14. All matches will consist of two halves of thirty (30) minutes each.
15. During the course of the game, referees and linesmen' decisions shall be final. **Any misconduct on the part of a player or coach may result in the disqualification of the entire team.** If there is any case where the referees report a player or team's conduct, the Tournament Disciplinary Committee shall take appropriate disciplinary action after hearing both parties. The same rule shall apply in the case of any team formally lodging a protest against biased or negligent conduct by the officials.
16. A maximum of three (3) outfield players **plus** a goalkeeper may be substituted in a single game.

Instructions:

1. Only those players born after December 15, 1989 and are enrolled as full time students of good standing may be registered to participate.
2. Any misrepresentation of players with regards to their age or academic standing will result in the school being disqualified from the on-going tournament and may be banned from all subsequent tournaments.
3. The Date of Birth of each student along with his picture **has to be stamped and signed by the school Principal** as verification that the particulars are correct as per school records. Failure to do so will disqualify the player.
